Maison de l'Europe

You are a volunteer of an association called "La Maison de l'Europe". Its goal is to promote European citizenship and culture. It offers ressources, training and advice to raise citizens' awareness on the current European Union major issues.



Europe Direct

La Maison de l'Europe is also a Europe Direct centre. It is a label given by the European Commission. There are about 500 centres spread throughout Europe. The goal is to inform citizens from Nantes and the wider region about the EU, and everything related to it. It is a link that connects the citizens with the European institutions.

Europa Nantes

Europa Nantes is a project that brings together 45 associations with a European vocation in one building. The space is about 1000m2 big and is open to the public.

At Europa Nantes, there is a radio, video, and podcast studio, a cafe, a European media library, an information point, eight classrooms (mostly used for language courses), a conference room and a kitchen.

Exhibitions and events (such as concerts) often take place at Europa Nantes. The first floor also host the offices of La Maison de l'Europe. Here is where you work.

Training courses Learn and meet new friends



You're taking part in two **training courses** in two different French towns with other European volunteers (around 30 each time). Themes such as **interculturality and Europe** are discussed. The training courses are an opportunity to network and make friends.

Around 40 European volunteers live in Nantes, and you'll have the chance to meet them at other meetings.

By volunteering with us, you are going to be able to develop **new professional and personal skills** that could be useful in your future career. The skills might be, for example, animation techniques, team projects, new tools and software, knowledge of the European Union, etc.





Useful Information

Food : You'll receive 7 euros per day, for the entire duration of your volunteering.

Pocket Money: You'll recerive 7 euros per day for the entire duration of your volunteering.

Travel: La Maison de l'Europe reimburses the round trip, according to the official Erasmus + Agency distance calculator. If you don't want to have any expenses to pay, you must not exceed the amount. If you choose to come by train, the grant is higher.


Language: La Maison de l'Europe will sign you up for a French course, for 4 hours a week for a minimum of 2 months.

Transport : You'll get a transport card for the entire Nantes metropolitan area

Accommodation: You'll be staying either in a residence for young workers with other European volunteers and people aged 18 to 30, or in a home-stay depending on availability. In all cases, you'll have your own room.
